Pino will be the Fair's new graphic designer. We look forward to seeing our new logo!



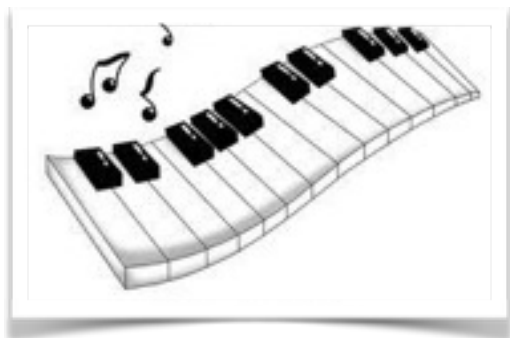
